The Court has subject matter jurisdiction over these proceedings, and this Petition is made pursuant to, Chapter 2.60 of the Tulalip Tribes Code of Law.

I. Subject Property

As described in detail in Tulalip Tribes Police Department Incident Report #24-0054, which is on file with the Tulalip Tribal Court under this cause number, on or about the 8th day of January, 2024, Tulalip Tribes Police Department (TTPD) seized a Beretta 92 SFS 9mm, serial no. BER088317Z, firearm from Michael Wiser in the vicinity of 6221 31st Avenue NE, Tulalip, WA 98271 in connection with narcotic trafficking on the Tulalip Reservation.

II. AUTHORITY

Because the Subject Firearm was possessed during the commission of a crime and further possessed to facilitate the transportation, sale, receipt, possession, or concealment of a controlled substance in violation of TTC 3.55, it is subject to forfeiture pursuant to Tulalip Tribal Code 2.60.020§(9).
