

COMES NOW the Tulalip Tribes, Plaintiff, by and through its prosecuting authority, to petition the Court to institute proceedings for the forfeiture of the property described in section I, below. The Court has subject matter jurisdiction over these proceedings, and this Petition is made pursuant to, Chapter 2.60 of the Tulalip Tribes Code of Law.

I. SUBJECT PROPERTY

As described in detail in Tulalip Police Incident Report #23-1762, which is on file with the Tulalip Tribal Court under this cause number, on or about the 14th day of June, 2023, Tulalip Tribal Police (TPD) seized a Silver Exam .380 Firearm with serial number 055000 from the center console of a 2012 Chevrolet Silverado, driven by Sergio Sandoval, Jr. and parked at the Quil Ceda Creek Casino located at 6221 31st Ave. NE, Tulalip, Washington in connection with narcotics trafficking on the Tulalip Reservation.

II. AUTHORITY

Because the Subject Firearm was used or was intended to be used to facilitate the transportation, sale, receipt, possession, or concealment of a controlled substance, listed chemical, or proceeds from the sale of a controlled substance in violation of Tulalip Law, the it is subject to forfeiture pursuant to Tulalip Tribal Code 2.60.020§(9).



1	III. CLAIMANTS
2	Sergio Sandoval, Jr., driver of the 2012 Chevy Silverado, from whom the subject
3	property was seized and, the legal owner of the vehicle in which the firearm was recovered,
4	Sergio Perez Segura, are the only entities that the Tribes knows or has reason to believe has or
5	may asset a claim to the subject property. Sergio Sandoval, Jr. is believed to reside at 233 Dorn,
6	Apartment 3, Everett, Washington 98208 (Police Report/DOL). Sergio Perez Segura is believed
.7	to reside at 233 Dorn, Apartment 3, Everett, Washington 98208 (Police Report/DOL).
8	IV. CONCLUSION
9	Based upon the foregoing, the Tribes requests the Clerk of the Court issue a Summons
10	to have Sergio Sandoval, Jr. and Sergio Perez Segura answer the allegations of this Petition, and,
11	ultimately, for the Court to order that the Subject Property be forfeited for the benefit of the
12	Tulalip Tribes.
