



TULALIP TRIBAL COURT LIMITED OPERATIONS PLAN AND UPDATED
ADMINISTRATIVE STANDING ORDER

March 31, 2020


As stated in previously issued Standing Administrative Orders, Court operations are substantially curtailed to help keep the public and our employees safe during the COVID-19 pandemic. We have entered an unprecedented time and are working hard to understand how best to go forward with court with the growing outbreak of COVID-19 for the Tulalip Tribes and the Tribal Court. The Tulalip Tribes Board of Directors have taken unprecedented actions to protect the community and address public health and safety and has issued a Quarantine or "Stay in Place" Mandate. The Court is an essential service and continues to function, albeit limited and will provide updates as to how the court schedule will be handled during the Quarantine for the month of April. However, this order addresses the time-frame for Court Operations through April 3, 2020 and will be replaced with a new order to be in place April 6- 30, 2020, or until time as the Quarantine is lifted or further order.

Therefore, the court hereby affirms and declares:

1. The General Order of March 16, 2020, posted hereafter is extended through April 3, 2020.
2. All Orders specific to case type: 3-18-2020 A, B, C and D are hereby extended through April 3, 2020.
3. An Order shall be issued prior to close of business April 3, 2020, detailing, to the extent possible, the Court operations April 6-30, 2020.

The court staff and judges will continue to monitor the court and the community's needs during this time, making adjustments as needed and provide further updated orders. This is a fluid situation and requires all of us to come together to continue to fulfill our duties and obligations while staying within the guidelines issued by the Center for Disease Control and Prevention, the Tulalip Tribes, the State and the Federal governments.
