3	owner of the vehicle, Artem Simonyan, are the only people who the Tribes knows or has reason
4	to believe has or may asset a claim to the subject property. Robert Artz is believed to be housed
5	at the Snohomish County Jail located at 3025 Oakes Avenue, Everett, Washington 98201.
6	Robert Artz is believed to reside at 7414 Ray Fryberg Drive, Tulalip, Washington 98271 (Police
7	Report). Artem Simonyan is believed to reside at 6031 208th Street SW, Apt. B15, Lynnwood,
8	Washington 98036 (Police Report).
9	IV. CONCLUSION
10	Based upon the foregoing, the Tribes requests the Clerk of the Court issue a Summons
11	to have Robert Artz and Artem Simonyan answer the allegations of this Petition, and, ultimately,
12	for the Court to order that the Subject Property be forfeited for the benefit of the Tulalip Tribes.
