COMES NOW the Tulalip Tribes, Plaintiff, by and through its prosecuting authority, to petition the Court to institute proceedings for the forfeiture of the property described in section I, below. The Court has subject matter jurisdiction over these proceedings, and this Petition is made pursuant to, Chapter 2.60 of the Tulalip Tribes Code of Law.

I. SUBJECT PROPERTY

As described in detail in Tulalip Police Incident Report #20-3182, which is on file with the Tulalip Tribal Court under this cause number, on or about the 26th day of December, 2020, Tulalip Tribal Police (TPD) seized a 2010 MERCEDES BENZ C220 & VIN #WDDGF5EB2AR109289 from Deion Fryberg (driver) in the vicinity of 6700 block of 27th Avenue NE, Tulalip, Washington in connection with narcotics trafficking on the Tulalip Reservation.

II. AUTHORITY

Because the Subject Vehicle was used or was intended to be used to facilitate the transportation, sale, receipt, possession, or concealment of a controlled substance, listed chemical, or proceeds from the sale of a controlled substance in violation of Tulalip Law, it is subject to forfeiture pursuant to Tulalip Tribal Code 2.60.020§(5).

III. **CLAIMANTS** 1 Deion Fryberg, driver, from whom the subject property was seized, the registered/legal 2 owner of the vehicle, Pengpeng Lin, and Ahmed Icamill, from whom the subject property was 3 sold to, are the only people who the Tribes knows or has reason to believe has or may asset a 4 claim to the subject property. Deion Fryberg is believed to reside at 8021 30th Drive NE, Tulalip, 5 Washington 98271 (Police Report). PengPeng Lin is believed to be residing at 17405 SE 139th 6 Place, Renton, Washington 98059 (Police Report). Ahmed Icamill is believed to be residing at 7 9610 56th Avenue S., Seattle, Washington 98118 (Police Report). 8 IV.
