YOU ARE HEREBY NOTIFIED that the Tulalip Tribes, Plaintiff, by and through its prosecuting authority, has filed a petition with the Court that seeks to have forfeited, to the benefit of the Tribes, certain property that you allegedly own, claim, or have an interest.

Pursuant to Chapter 2.60.070§(4)(a), of the Tulalip Tribes Code of Law, you have thirty (30) days after you have been served the petition and this summons to file with the Court a response to the allegations described in the petition. No extension of the time for filing the response may be granted. Failure to respond within 30 days may bar you from presenting evidence at any later evidentiary hearing regarding the seized property. Further, if no response is filed within 30 days after service of the petition and summons, the Court, upon motion of the Tribes, shall order the property forfeited to the Tribes.

Chapter 2.60.070§(4)(b) governs responses to forfeiture petitions. The Clerk's Office does not provide legal advice. It is your responsibility to familiarize yourself with the applicable

COMES NOW the Tulalip Tribes, Plaintiff, by and through its prosecuting authority, to petition the Court to institute proceedings for the forfeiture of the property described in section I, below. The Court has subject matter jurisdiction over these proceedings, and this Petition is made pursuant to, Chapter 2.60 of the Tulalip Tribes Code of Law.

I. SUBJECT PROPERTY

As described in detail in Tulalip Police Incident Report #20-2230, which is on file with the Tulalip Tribal Court under this cause number, on or about the 11th day of September, 2020, Tulalip Tribal Police (TPD) seized a 2008 Audi A4 & VIN # WAUAF48H38K016453 from Mark Gallardo (driver) in the vicinity of 6410 33rd Avenue NE, Tulalip, Washington in connection with narcotics trafficking on the Tulalip Reservation.

П. **AUTHORITY**

Because the Subject Vehicle was used or was intended to be used to facilitate the transportation, sale, receipt, possession, or concealment of a controlled substance, listed chemical, or proceeds from the sale of a controlled substance in violation of Tulalip Law, it is subject to forfeiture pursuant to Tulalip Tribal Code 2.60.020§(5).

III. CLAIMANTS

Mark Gallardo, driver, from whom the subject property was seized and the registered legal owner of the vehicle, Kerrie Wise, are the only people who the Tribes knows or has reason to believe has or may asset a claim to the subject property. Mark Gallardo last known residence is 16910 72nd Avenue NE, Kenmore, Washington 98028 (Police Report). Mark Gallardo is currently housed at the Monroe Correctional Complex with an estimated release date of September 28, 2020. Monroe Correctional Complex's mailing address is 16550 177th Avenue Se, Monroe, Washington 98272 (Booking Information). Kerrie Wise is currently believed to be residing at 10637 SE 238th Street, Kent, Washington 98031 (Police Report).

IV. CONCLUSION

Based upon the foregoing, the Tribes requests the Clerk of the Court issue a Summons to have Mark Gallardo and Kerri Wise answer the allegations of this Petition, and, ultimately, for the Court to order that the Subject Property be forfeited for the benefit of the Tulalip Tribes.


