#### I. SUBJECT PROPERTY

As described in detail in Tulalip Police Incident Report #20-2708, which is on file with the Tulalip Tribal Court under this cause number, on or about the 27<sup>th</sup> day of October, 2020, Tulalip Tribal Police (TPD) seized a \$265 from Aubree Lester-Vaivaimuli in the vicinity of 10200 Quil Ceda Blvd., Tulalip, Washington in connection with narcotics trafficking on the Tulalip Reservation.

# II. AUTHORITY

Because the Subject Money was furnished or intended to be furnished by any person in exchange for a controlled substance or listed chemical in violation of Tulalip Law, it is subject to forfeiture pursuant to Tulalip Tribal Code 2.60.020§(7).

7	Vaivaimuli is currently housed at the Department of Corrections located at 7345 Linderson Way
8	SW, Tumwater, Washington 98501 (Jail Registry) with an estimated release date of December
	2, 2020.

10	IV. CONCLUSION Based upon the foregoing the Tribes requests the Clerk of the Court issue a Summary
11	Based upon the foregoing, the Tribes requests the Clerk of the Court issue a Summons
