COMES NOW the Tulalip Tribes, Plaintiff, by and through its prosecuting authority, to petition the Court to institute proceedings for the forfeiture of the property described in section I, below. The Court has subject matter jurisdiction over these proceedings, and this Petition is made pursuant to, Chapter 2.60 of the Tulalip Tribes Code of Law.

I. SUBJECT PROPERTY

As described in detail in Tulalip Police Incident Report #20-2677, which is on file with the Tulalip Tribal Court under this cause number, on or about the 24th day of October, 2020, Tulalip Tribal Police (TPD) seized a \$1,231 from Joshua Spaulding in the vicinity of 10200 Quil Ceda Blvd., Tulalip, Washington in connection with narcotics trafficking on the Tulalip Reservation.

II. AUTHORITY

Because the Subject Money was furnished or intended to be furnished by any person in exchange for a controlled substance or listed chemical in violation of Tulalip Law, or any instrumentality used, or intended to be used, in any manner or part, to commit, or to facilitate, the commission of any Class F crime as defined by Tulalip Tribal law, or any property expressly subject to seizure or forfeiture under any other provision of Tulalip Tribal law that adopts this

1	chapter by reference, is subject to forfeiture pursuant to Tulalip Tribal Code
2	2.60.020§(7)(10)(11).
3	III. CLAIMANTS
4	Joshua Spaulding, from whom the subject property was seized, is the only person who
5	the Tribes knows or has reason to believe has or may assert a claim to the subject property.
6	Joshua Spaulding is believed to be residing at 2800 Western Avenue, Apt. 119, Seattle,
7	Washington 98134 (Police Report).
8	IV. CONCLUSION
9	Based upon the foregoing, the Tribes requests the Clerk of the Court issue a Summons
10	to have Joshua Spaulding answer the allegations of this Petition, and, ultimately, for the Court
11	to order that the Subject Property be forfeited for the benefit of the Tulalip Tribes.
