benefit of the Tribes, certain property that you allegedly own, claim, or have an interest.

Pursuant to Chapter 2.60.070§(4)(a), of the Tulalip Tribes Code of Law, you have thirty (30) days after you have been served the petition and this summons to file with the Court a response to the allegations described in the petition. No extension of the time for filing the response may be granted. Failure to respond within 30 days may bar you from presenting evidence at any later evidentiary hearing regarding the seized property. Further, if no response is filed within 30 days after service of the petition and summons, the Court, upon motion of the Tribes, shall order the property forfeited to the Tribes.

PETITION FOR FORFEITURE OF SEIZED PROPERTY

COMES NOW the Tulalip Tribes, Plaintiff, by and through its prosecuting authority, to petition the Court to institute proceedings for the forfeiture of the property described in section I, below. The Court has subject matter jurisdiction over these proceedings, and this Petition is made pursuant to, Chapter 2.60 of the Tulalip Tribes Code of Law.

I. SUBJECT PROPERTY

As described in detail in Tulalip Police Incident Report #21-0030, which is on file with the Tulalip Tribal Court under this cause number, on or about the 4th day of January, 2021, Tulalip Tribal Police (TPD) seized a 2020 Honda Civic & VIN #19XFC2F81LE204280 from Christopher Waters (driver) in the vicinity of 8300 block of 27th Avenue NE, Tulalip, Washington in connection with narcotics trafficking on the Tulalip Reservation.

II. AUTHORITY

Because the Subject Vehicle was used or was intended to be used to facilitate the transportation, sale, receipt, possession, or concealment of a controlled substance, listed chemical, or proceeds from the sale of a controlled substance in violation of Tulalip Law, it is subject to forfeiture pursuant to Tulalip Tribal Code 2.60.020§(5).

1	III. CLAIMANTS
2	Christopher Waters, driver, from whom the subject property was seized, the registered
3	owner of the vehicle, Kathy Shake, and the legal owner of the vehicle, American Honda Finance,
4	are the only people who the Tribes knows or has reason to believe has or may asset a claim to
5	the subject property. Christopher Waters is believed to reside at 2908 122 nd Street SW, Everett,
6	Washington 98204 (Police Report). Kathy Shake is believed to reside at 4016 82rd Drive NE,
7	Marysville, Washington 98270 (Police Report). American Honda Finance has a mailing address
8	of P.O. Box 997521, Sacramento, California 95899 (Police Report).
9	IV. CONCLUSION
10	Based upon the foregoing, the Tribes requests the Clerk of the Court issue a Summons
11	to have Christopher Waters, Kathy Shake, and American Honda Finance answer the allegations
12	of this Petition, and, ultimately, for the Court to order that the Subject Property be forfeited for
13	the benefit of the Tulalip Tribes.
