COMES NOW the Tulalip Tribes, Plaintiff, by and through its prosecuting authority, to petition the Court to institute proceedings for the forfeiture of the property described in section I, below. The Court has subject matter jurisdiction over these proceedings, and this Petition is made pursuant to, Chapter 2.60 of the Tulalip Tribes Code of Law.

I. SUBJECT PROPERTY

As described in detail in Tulalip Police Incident Report #21-0423, which is on file with the Tulalip Tribal Court under this cause number, on or about the 19th day of February, 2021, Tulalip Tribal Police (TPD) seized a 2014 Infiniti Q50 VIN # JN1AV7AR1EM703251 from Soohui Kim (driver/registered owner) in the vicinity of 33rd Avenue NE and Marine Drive NE, Tulalip, Washington in connection with narcotics trafficking on the Tulalip Reservation.

II. AUTHORITY

Because the Subject Vehicle was used or was intended to be used to facilitate the transportation, sale, receipt, possession, or concealment of a controlled substance, listed chemical, or proceeds from the sale of a controlled substance in violation of Tulalip Law, it is subject to forfeiture pursuant to Tulalip Tribal Code 2.60.020§(5).

III. **CLAIMANTS**

Soohui Kim, driver/registered owner, from whom the subject property was seized and the legal owner of the vehicle, Boeing Employees Credit Union, are the only people who the Tribes knows or has reason to believe has or may asset a claim to the subject property. Soohui Kim is believed to reside at 3331 204th Street SW, Apt. D304, Lynnwood, Washington 98036 (Police Report). Soohui Kim is being housed at the Snohomish County Jail located at 3025 Oakes Avenue, Everett, Washington 98201 (Jail Registry). Boeing Employees Credit Union has a mailing address of P.O. Box 997500, Sacramento, California 95899 (Police Report).

CONCLUSION

Based upon the foregoing, the Tribes requests the Clerk of the Court issue a Summons to have Soohui Kim and Boeing Employees Credit Union answer the allegations of this Petition, and, ultimately, for the Court to order that the Subject Property be forfeited for the benefit of the
