SUBJECT PROPERTY I.

As described in detail in Tulalip Police Incident Report #23-1762, which is on file with the Tulalip Tribal Court under this cause number, on or about the 6th day of June, 2023, Tulalip Tribal Police (TPD) seized a 2012 Ford Focus & VIN #1FAHP3F20CL303071 from Sergio Sandoval Jr. (driver) in the vicinity of 33rd Avenue NE, Tulalip, Washington in connection with narcotics trafficking on the Tulalip Reservation.

II. AUTHORITY

Because the Subject Vehicle was used or was intended to be used to facilitate the transportation, sale, receipt, possession, or concealment of a controlled substance, listed chemical, or proceeds from the sale of a controlled substance in violation of Tulalip Law, it is subject to forfeiture pursuant to Tulalip Tribal Code 2.60.020§(5).

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III. CLAIMANTS

Sergio Sandoval, Jr., driver, from whom the subject property was seized, the legal owner of the vehicle, Francisco Rueda Zamora, and the credit agency, Reliable Credit Association, Inc., are the only entities that the Tribes knows or has reason to believe has or may asset a claim to the subject property. Sergio Sandoval, Jr. is believed to reside at 233 Dorn, Everett, Washington 98208 (Police Report/DOL). Francisco Rueda Zamora is believed to reside at 9516 Chapel Hill Road, Lake Stevens, Washington, 98258 (DOL). Reliable Credit Association, Inc. is located at P.O. Box 836, Lynwood, Washington 98046-0836.

IV. CONCLUSION

Based upon the foregoing, the Tribes requests the Clerk of the Court issue a Summons to have Sergio Sandoval, Jr., Francisco Rueda Zamora, and Reliable Credit Association, Inc. answer the allegations of this Petition, and, ultimately, for the Court to order that the Subject Property be forfeited for the benefit of the Tulalip Tribes.
