SUBJECT PROPERTY

As described in detail in Tulalip Police Incident Report #18-3721, which is on file with the Tulalip Tribal Court under this cause number, on or about the 13th day of December, 2018, Tulalip Tribal Police (TPD) seized a \$1,770 from Amber Mendoza-Redstone in the vicinity of 8629 27th Avenue NE, Tulalip, Washington in connection with narcotics trafficking on the Tulalip Reservation.

AUTHORITY II.

Because the Subject Money was furnished or intended to be furnished by any person in exchange for a controlled substance or listed chemical in violation of Tulalip Law, it is subject to forfeiture pursuant to Tulalip Tribal Code 2.60.020§(7).

1	III. CLAIMANTS
2	Amber Mendoza-Redstone, from whom the subject property was seized, is the only
3	person who the Tribes knows or has reason to believe has or may assert a claim to the subject
4	property. She is housed at the Snohomish County Jail located at 3025 Oakes Avenue, Everett,
5	Washington 98201 (booking inquiry).
6	IV. CONCLUSION
7	Based upon the foregoing, the Tribes requests the Clerk of the Court issue a Summons
8	to have Amber Mendoza-Redstone answer the allegations of this Petition, and, ultimately, for
9	the Court to order that the Subject Property be forfeited for the benefit of the Tulalip Tribes.
