COMES NOW the Tulalip Tribes, Plaintiff, by and through its prosecuting authority, to petition the Court to institute proceedings for the forfeiture of the property described in section I, below. The Court has subject matter jurisdiction over these proceedings, and this Petition is made pursuant to, Chapter 2.60 of the Tulalip Tribes Code of Law.

I. SUBJECT PROPERTY

As described in detail in Tulalip Police Incident Report #18-3546, which is on file with the Tulalip Tribal Court under this cause number, on or about the 21st day of November, 2018, Tulalip Tribal Police (TPD) seized a \$612.28 from Patrice Hundiye in the vicinity of 2729 Old Tulalip Road, Tulalip, Washington in connection with narcotics trafficking on the Tulalip Reservation.

II. AUTHORITY

Because the Subject Money was furnished or intended to be furnished by any person in exchange for a controlled substance or listed chemical in violation of Tulalip Law, it is subject to forfeiture pursuant to Tulalip Tribal Code 2.60.020§(7).



1	III. CLAIMANTS
2	Patrice Hundiye, from whom the subject property was seized, is the only person who the
3	Tribes knows or has reason to believe has or may assert a claim to the subject property. She is
4	believed to be residing at 8213 21st Avenue NE, A, Tulalip, Washington 98271 (Police Report)
5	or 7616 19th Avenue NE, A, Tulalip, Washington 98271 (Judicial Information System "JIS").
6	IV. CONCLUSION
7	Based upon the foregoing, the Tribes requests the Clerk of the Court issue a Summons
8	to have Patrice Hundiye answer the allegations of this Petition, and, ultimately, for the Court to
9	order that the Subject Property be forfeited for the benefit of the Tulalip Tribes.
