COMES NOW the Tulalip Tribes, Plaintiff, by and through its prosecuting authority, to petition the Court to institute proceedings for the forfeiture of the property described in section I, below. The Court has subject matter jurisdiction over these proceedings, and this Petition is made pursuant to, Chapter 2.60 of the Tulalip Tribes Code of Law.

I. SUBJECT PROPERTY

As described in detail in Tulalip Police Incident Report #18-4011, which is on file with the Tulalip Tribal Court under this cause number, on or about the 31st day of December, 2018, Tulalip Tribal Police (TPD) seized a 2007 Toyota Prius, VIN #JTDKB20UX73228579 from Ruben Escalante (driver) in the vicinity of 6323 33rd Avenue NE, Tulalip, Washington in connection with narcotics trafficking on the Tulalip Reservation.

II. AUTHORITY

Because the Subject Vehicle was used or was intended to be used to facilitate the transportation, sale, receipt, possession, or concealment of a controlled substance, listed chemical, or proceeds from the sale of a controlled substance in violation of Tulalip Law, it is subject to forfeiture pursuant to Tulalip Tribal Code 2.60.020§(5).

1	III. CLAIMANTS									
2	Ruben Escalante, from whom the subject property was seized, the registered owner of									
3	the vehicle, Juan Escalante, and the legal owner of the vehicle, Qualstar Credit Union, are the									
4	only people/entities who the Tribes knows or has reason to believe has or may asset a claim to									
5	the subject property. Ruben Escalante and Juan Escalante are believed to reside at 6206 72 nd									
6	Street NE, Marysville, Washington 98270 (Police Report). Qualstar Credit Union mailing									
7	information is P.O. Box 96730, Bellevue, Washington 98009 (Police Report).									
8	IV. CONCLUSION									
9	Based upon the foregoing, the Tribes requests the Clerk of the Court issue a Summons									
10	to have Ruben Escalante (driver), Juan Escalante (registered owner), and Qualstar Credit Unior									
11	(legal owner) answer the allegations of this Petition, and, ultimately, for the Court to order that									
12	the Subject Property be forfeited for the benefit of the Tulalip Tribes.
