III. CLAIMANTS
Kyle Hester (driver), from whom the subject property was seized and the registered
owners of the vehicle, Ron and Kerry Hester, are the only people who the Tribes knows or has
reason to believe has or may asset a claim to the subject property. Kyle Hester is believed to
reside at 20 N. Camano Ridge Road, Camano Island, Washington 98282 (Police Report). Ron
and Kerry Hester are believed to reside at 9406 Loganberry Lane, Everett, Washington 98204
(Judicial Information System "JIS").
IV. CONCLUSION
Based upon the foregoing, the Tribes requests the Clerk of the Court issue a Summons
to have Kyle Hester (driver) and Ron and Kerry Hester (registered owners) answer the
allegations of this Petition, and, ultimately, for the Court to order that the Subject Property be
forfeited for the benefit of the Tulalip Tribes.
