As described in detail in Tulalip Police Incident Report #18-2860, which is on file with the Tulalip Tribal Court under this cause number, on or about the 19th day of September, 2018, Tulalip Tribal Police (TPD) seized a 2007 BMW 3 Series, VIN #WBAVC93547KZ72057 from Daniel Bellotti in the vicinity of 8924 Quil Ceda Blvd., Tulalip, Washington in connection with narcotics trafficking on the Tulalip Reservation.

AUTHORITY II.

Because the Subject Vehicle was used or was intended to be used to facilitate the transportation, sale, receipt, possession, or concealment of a controlled substance, listed chemical, or proceeds from the sale of a controlled substance in violation of Tulalip Law, it is subject to forfeiture pursuant to Tulalip Tribal Code 2.60.020§(5).

1	III. CLAIMANTS
2	Daniel Bellotti, from whom the subject property was seized the registered owner of the
3	vehicle, are the only persons who the Tribes knows or has reason to believe has or may asset a
4	claim to the subject property. Daniel Bellotti is believed to reside at 14028 61st Place W., Apt.
5	C, Edmonds, Washington 98026 (Police Report).
6	IV. CONCLUSION
7	Based upon the foregoing, the Tribes requests the Clerk of the Court issue a Summons
8	to have Daniel Bellotti (Registered Owner) answer the allegations of this Petition, and,
9	ultimately, for the Court to order that the Subject Property be forfeited for the benefit of the
10	Tulalip Tribes.
