you were served outside the State of Washington,	you must respond within sixty (60) days after date of
service. See Tulalip Tribal Code Title 2, Ch.2.10,Se	ec.2.10.030(2)(d)(i-ii).
If you wish to seek the advice of an attorney in this	matter, you should do so promptly so that your written
response, if any, may be served on time. You have the right to counsel at your own expense.
