I. Subject Property

As described in detail in Tulalip Tribes Police Department Incident Report #25-1191, which is on file with the Tulalip Tribal Court under this cause number, on or about the 25th day of April, 2025, Tulalip Tribes Police Department (TTPD) seized a 2007 Mercedes Benz, VIN No. WDBUF56X87B065077 from Ariana JanineYazzie (driver/legal owner) in the vicinity of 6221 31st Avenue NE Tulalip, WA 98271 in connection with narcotic trafficking on the Tulalip Reservation.

II. AUTHORITY

Because the Subject Vehicle was used or was intended to be used to facilitate the transportation, sale, receipt, possession, or concealment of a controlled substance, listed chemical, or proceeds from the sale of a controlled substance in violation of Tulalip Law, it is subject to forfeiture pursuant to Tulalip Tribal Code 2.60.020§(5).
