Subject Property As described in detail in Tulalip Tribes Police Department Incident Report #25-3217, 17 which is on file with the Tulalip Tribal Court under this cause number, on or about the 5th day 18 of November, 2025, Tulalip Tribes Police Department (TTPD) seized a 2015 Chrysler 300, 19 Vin No. 2C3CCAAG9FH859280 from Carmen Peterman (driver) in the vicinity of 3300 20 block of Marine Drive NE Tulalip, WA 98271 in connection with narcotic trafficking on the 21 Tulalip Reservation. 22 II. AUTHORITY 23 Because the Subject Vehicle was used or was intended to be used to facilitate the transportation, sale, receipt, possession, or concealment of a controlled substance, listed 24 chemical, or proceeds from the sale of a controlled substance in violation of Tulalip Law, it is 25



subject to forfeiture pursuant to Tulalip Tribal Code 2.60.020§(5).
