COMES NOW the Tulalip Tribes, Plaintiff, by and through its prosecuting authority, to petition the Court to institute proceedings for the forfeiture of the property described in section I, below. The Court has subject matter jurisdiction over these proceedings, and this Petition is made pursuant to, Chapter 2.60 of the Tulalip Tribes Code of Law.

I. Subject Property

As described in detail in Tulalip Tribes Police Department Incident Report #25-0934, which is on file with the Tulalip Tribal Court under this cause number, on or about the April 2, 2025, Tulalip Tribes Police Department (TTPD) seized a 2018 Toyota RAV4 VIN #2T3DFREV5JW831385 from StevenPollock (driver) in the vicinity of 6221 31st Avenue NE Tulalip, WA 98271 in connection with narcotic trafficking on the Tulalip Reservation.

II. AUTHORITY

Because the Subject Vehicle was used or was intended to be used to facilitate the transportation, sale, receipt, possession, or concealment of a controlled substance, listed chemical, or proceeds from the sale of a controlled substance in violation of Tulalip Law, it is subject to forfeiture pursuant to Tulalip Tribal Code 2.60.020§(5).

9	Based upon the foregoing, the Tribes requests the Clerk of the Court issue a Summons
10	to have StevenPollock and Boeing Employee Credit Union answer the allegations of this
11	Petition, and, ultimately, for the Court to order that the Subject Property be forfeited for the
12	benefit of the Tulalip Tribes.
